REGISTRATION & RECORDS

Starting March 2019: If you have not received an email from My Catholic Faith Delivered with a link to complete registration, contact your coordinator with your email address to be added to the system.

Once an account is created, you will receive an email inviting you to complete registration. Formation options can then be selected. Selections will be recorded automatically for live workshops and most online courses. Other formation can simply be uploaded for approval.

Leaders will also be invited to create an account with administrator status, in order to have access to catechists records. Through this platform, you can easily inform and encourage catechists to fulfill formation requirements.
